SVDB Beach Hunt Rules:

- Entrants must provide their own metal detector and beach digging tools (sand scoops, baskets, etc.).
- All holes made in the sand must be filled to avoid injuries to beach goers.

- Keep a distance of 20-25 feet from all beachgoers that are sitting on the beach during the open beach hunts.
- Keep everything you dig. TRASH should be kept and deposited in **Trash Containers**.
- All detectorists are requested to sign up in advance, and pose for a group picture the day of the hunt.
- Must be a valid paid in full SVDB Member and wear your name tag during the hunts.
- Must wear Headphones at all times.
- Coils cannot be larger than 12 inches for the three seeded hunts.
- No Pulse Induction (PIs) can be used during the seeded hunts. PIN POINTERS are OK.

Suggested Departure Options for the Outing:

- ✓ Drive down Early Sunday Morning leave Sacramento Area on or before 3:00 am gets you to Santa Cruz at 6:00 am.
- ✓ Stay Saturday & Sunday night for the Sunday & Monday hunts. Drive back Monday afternoon or stay another day.
- ✓ Sunday @ Seacliff State Park at **Rio Mar (meet here)** just south of Seacliff State Park Beach there is **FREE Parking with an Entrance to the Seacliff State Park Beach**.
- ✓ Sunday Evening & Monday Santa Cruz Parking: Meter Parking Available, Meters Start @ 10:00 am, 10 MINUTES for a Quarter. (Meters Take Quarters / Dollars Coins \$1.50/hour)

- Take Highway #1 to Chestnut Street (Top of the hill at the signal light go straight ahead on Chestnut)
- Follow Chestnut turn left onto Laurel Street
- Take Laurel turn right onto Center Street
- Take Center to the intersection by the Santa Cruz Pier (This should be Beach Street)
- Cross Beach Street- to the right of the pier entrance is a public beach access
- The Public Beach Access is the meeting place to start and end Sunday's four hunts.
- Meter parking available on the street 10 minutes for .25cents-bring quarters. Meters Start at 10:00 am.

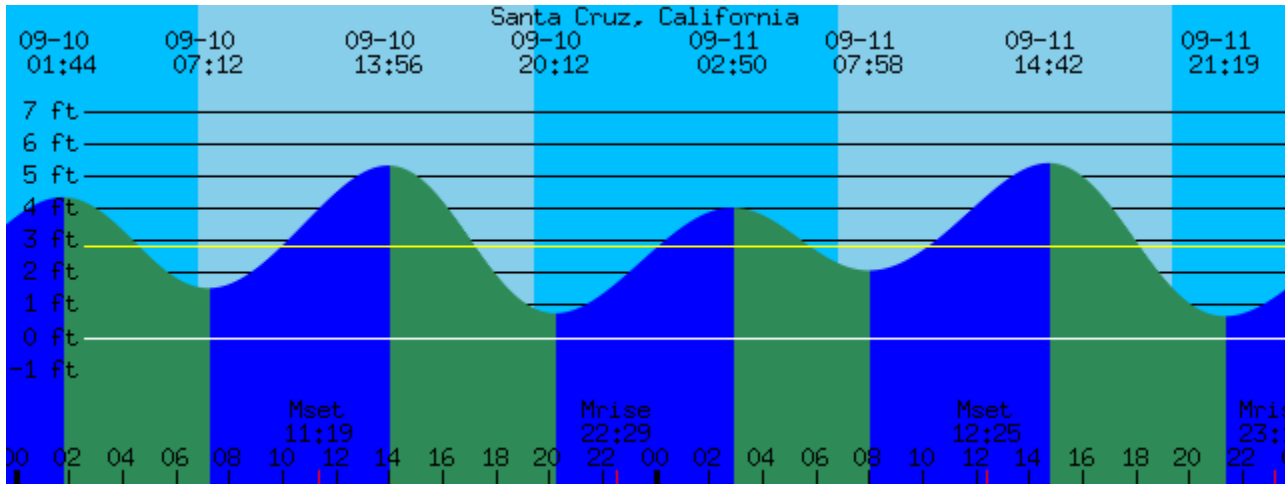

Direction to Rio Del Mar:

At the Highway 17 and Highway 1 intersection, take Highway 1 South and go to Rio Del Mar Blvd 7.2 miles. Take the exit to Rio Del Mar Blvd and turn right. Follow this road and it will take you to the beach and Rio Del Mar. There is a walk bridge at the far right of the parking lot which will provide access to Sea Cliff State Park. Parking is free.

Sea Cliff State Park: Take State Park Drive which is 6 miles from Highway 17 & 1 intersection. Access to the Park is \$10 for day use or \$9 for seniors.
