- **Tom Boyd's** Recovery Team had one request last month which brought \$80.00 to the club treasury.

Entry fees will be \$40 for members (\$5 extra on the day of the hunt) and \$12 for kids. The May club meeting on the 2nd will be the cut off for the \$40 fee so don't be late. Non-hunting volunteers are needed on the day of the hunt to seed the field. Please bring food according to the following list:
