Tom reported that the library continues to receive great donations. Tom will not be here for the October meeting because he will be on the high seas again.

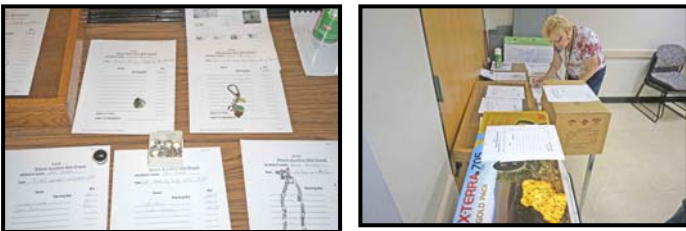
Recovery Report: Tom Boyd
